COVID-19 Temperature Check Procedure



Supplies

- Thermometer
- Gloves
- Mask

- Hand Sanitizer
- Alcohol/Sanitizing wipes

Setup

Each medical professional should wear a mask and two gloves (one per hand) while providing the service. Change gloves if they come in contact with a participant. Sanitize the thermometer if it comes in contact with a participant. Change gloves and sanitize the thermometer after each temperature of 100.4°F or higher.

Service Delivery

As participants arrive, verbally ask each one the following three questions:

- 1. Have you had any known exposure to, or contact with, any individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last two weeks? YES/NO
- 2. Have you or anyone in your household traveled to a COVID-19 hot spot in the last two weeks? YES/NO
- 3. Do you have any of the following symptoms? YES/NO
 - a. Fever of 100.4 degrees F or higher?
 - b. Persistent cough?
 - c. Shortness of breath?

If the participant answers No to all three questions, proceed with taking the participant's temperature. Show the participant their temperature reading on the thermometer. If the participant's temperature is under 100.4°F allow them to enter the facility.

If a participant answers Yes to any of the above questions or has a temperature of 100.4°F or higher, ask the participant to return home. The participant should also contact the company's HR representative.

Event Completion

At the completion of each event leave the thermometer(s) and additional supplies onsite with the site contact. You are not required to complete or return a time log for temperature check events. However, if you do stay past the scheduled end time, please contact your account manager to let them know.
